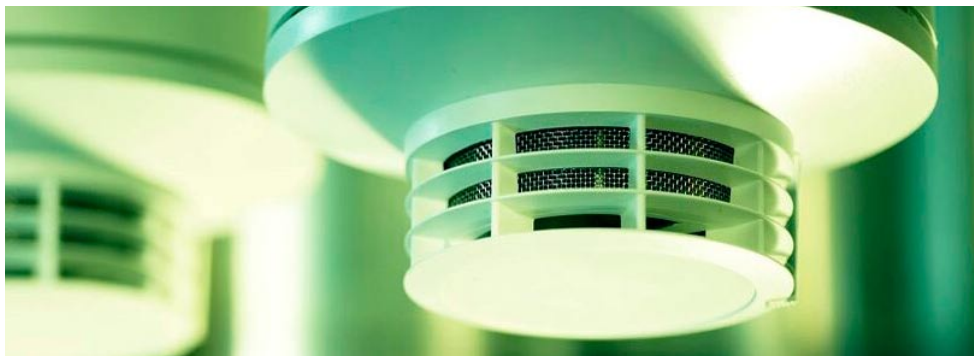
With a whole new range of technical innovations the SecuriStar® fire detectors are now more intelligent than ever.

The Securistar H is the first fire detector which, once installed, no longer requires configuration with a complex set of parameters; instead it adapts permanently and entirely autonomously to its environment. With the help of the self-developed «cube levelling system» the new fire detector continuously measures ambient parameters such as absolute temperature, the relative temperature rise, and any air murkiness. It then uses these values to determine the optimum sensitivity for each operating site and adapts to the prevailing circumstances.

#### **Deception alarms on the defensive**

Maximum fire detection accuracy is the result of improved smoke and temperature symmetry, interconnected sensors, optimised smoke penetration response and new alarm filters. With the operating mechanism now consistently optimised in this way, the

With its three detector types the new SecuriStar® line is an absolute allrounder. Under its elegant exterior the MTD 533 combines a smoke detector and a heat sensor. While the UTD 533 is a steadfast heat detector, the MSD 533 uses scattered light to detect instantly any open fires generating smoke. This versatile range of products means that Securiton is able to ensure that every environment is monitored by precisely the right type of detector. ■

## Carlsbad's «13th spring», reliably protected against fire with products from Securiton

**Carlsbad (Karlovy Vary) in the Czech Republic is famous the world over for its 12 hot springs. Their therapeutic effect has been known since the 14th century, and today the springs are a popular destination for visitors from all over the world, who travel to Carlsbad for spa and other treatments.**

The fashion of taking the waters began in the 16th century, when numerous illustrious emperors and tsars travelled to Carlsbad to seek the healing powers of hot springs.

Depending on the illness, water from the 12 healing springs is taken either in a particular sequence or only individually, to obtain relief from a variety of complaints. But if you ask the inhabitants of Carlsbad for the town's best known therapeutic source, they will immediately mention the 13th «spring». And by that they mean the famous herb liqueur Becherovka, which

is manufactured exclusively in Carlsbad. The secret and highly successful formula for the herbal bitter known as Karlovarská Becherovka was invented exactly 200 years ago in the pharmacy of Mr. Josef Becher. The recipe was later passed on to his son Jan Becher, who pressed ahead with large-scale production and worldwide distribution. Even today only two people know the secret recipe, which comprises 20 herbs, essences and alcohol.

Various Securiton products have been installed to protect the Becherovka premises. Our local partner Tribase Networking

spol s.r.o. installed a SecuriPro® system and a SecuriRas® ASD 516 aspiration smoke detector system in the historical buildings used for production and administration. The warehouses are protected by several SecuriSens® ADW 511 Transafe linear heat detectors. These installations ensure that any fires are detected quickly, safely and reliably. ■

## International Sales Meeting 2007

**Securiton held its 4th International Sales Meeting from 4 to 6 June 2007. 40 partners (58 persons) from 31 countries took part in this three-day event, which was held in Lucerne this year. The ISM is an information exchange platform between Securiton and its partner companies and enables them to network.**

The first day of the meeting took place at the NH Hotel in Lucerne where all the participants were accommodated. After the opening addresses by Mr. Guido Portmann and Mr. Stefan Kühne, the present partner companies have been shortly introduced by their responsible area sales manager. Then, Mr. Adrian Staub informed everybody about the latest Securiton product developments. After lunch some partners presented some project highlights which

have been realised recently. In the afternoon the group visited the Rosengart Collection in Lucerne, which comprises well over 200 works by 23 different «Classic Modernist» artists, including 125 works by Paul Klee and some 50 by Pablo Picasso. The Rosengart Collection is located in the former building of the Swiss National Bank and protected by Securiton fire alarm and intrusion systems. Dinner was held at the famous Hotel Montana. The following

morning everybody met again in the congress room of the NH Hotel. Mr. Antonio Santagata informed the partners about the processes in the customer service department. Then, the companies Sauter, Bixi Systems and polyright SA gave a presentation about their business fields and informed the attendees about a possible collaboration in the future. After the lunch break, the group was transferred to the Swiss Paraplegics Centre in Nottwil, which offers a holistic rehabilitation for paraplegics. ## Security for Moscow Basketball Temple

**Moscow's prestigious club Dynamo has built a basketball venue certain to make other clubs green with envy. It's certainly one of the reasons why the Club in Moscow's western district of Krylatskoe has built a brand new, state-of-the-art «basketball palace». The sports venue was recently officially inaugurated, with the necessary support of the Russian government. The new stadium holds 5000 spectators, which is why security was also a prime concern for the operators of the new complex.
